- 10) Utilize HTML, Javascript, jQuery, and Bootstrap to create dynamic mobile-friendly designs focused on user interactions and experience.
- 11) Create mockup wireframes for various improvements to the front-end system of the company's website and work closely with development staff to migrate wireframes to live system.
- 12) Oversee technical team and provide guidance towards completion of tasks by utilizing Agile methodologies.
